

Over 4,777 participants have enrolled in COVID 19 Test Us studies. The newest of these studies is the Test Us at Home study.

What is the Test Us at Home study?

The Test Us at Home study will help researchers learn more about the best ways to test for COVID-19 at home. Participants in this study do not have COVID-19 symptoms. Participants receive instructions in the mail to help them take two COVID-19 tests at home every other day for two weeks – this is called serial testing. One test is an over-the-counter test kit used at home that does not need a prescription, and the other test is a standard test mailed to a laboratory. The home test is read by the participant at home in 15 minutes. Participants record the home test results in an app on a smart phone or device.

Participants in COVID-19 Test Us, age 14 or older, have started to join the Test Us at Home study to help researchers compare the accuracy of home tests to standard lab tests.

Participation in the Test Us at Home study can help researchers develop reliable home tests.

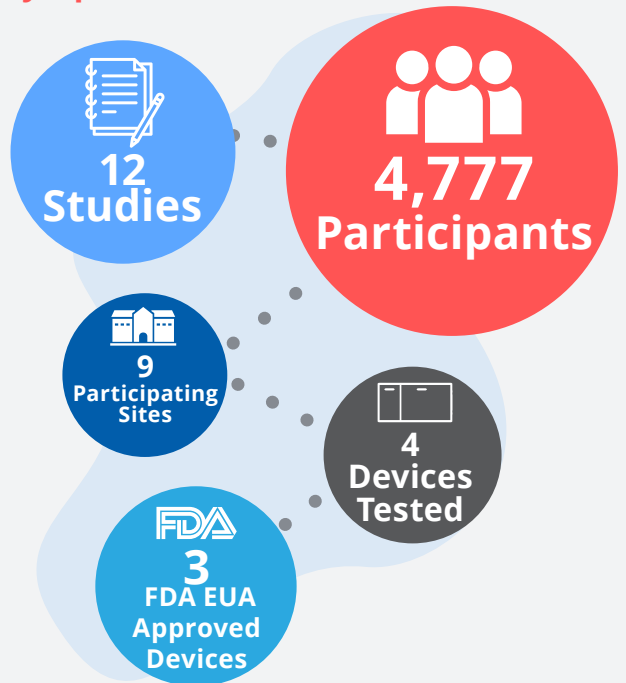
